

EPUNet-2003

The 2003 Conference of the European Panel Users Network

3–5 July 2003, Colchester UK

The inaugural Conference of the European Panel Users Network (EPUNet) aims to provide an international forum for the exchange of research based on the European Community Household Panel survey (ECHP). The conference will include parallel sessions and a small number of plenary sessions. Submissions of papers are sought on all topics covered by the ECHP, regardless of the disciplinary affiliations of the authors (cross-disciplinary interchange is one of the conference goals). Papers may take national or cross-national perspectives, and papers about methods are also encouraged. The 2003 British Household Panel Survey Research Conference is being held concurrently and at the same venue as EPUNet-2003, and participants will be able to attend both conferences. Attendance by persons not presenting papers is welcome, subject to the venue's constraints on numbers. There is no conference fee. Contributions towards the travel and accommodation costs of presenters will be available.

CALL FOR PAPERS (submission deadline 15 February 2003)

200–400 word abstracts of papers for presentation at the EPUNet-2003 Conference should be submitted by 15 February 2003, together with a draft of the complete paper if available. Submissions based on complete papers are likely to given preference in acceptance over those based on an abstract, other things equal. The preliminary programme will be emailed to those submitting papers by mid-March 2003. Appearance of a paper in the preliminary programme implies acceptance of a submission.

In order to gauge numbers attending, potential participants (whether presenting or not) are requested to make a preliminary registration (email: epunet-2003@isermail.essex.ac.uk), by 15 February 2003, indicating whether their participation probability is low/medium/definite.
