Arriving at Tegel Airport

Tegel Airport is close to the city center. Travelling to and from the airport is easy. The airport is accessible via bus. Please buy an AB ticket at the BVG ticket machines in advance or in the BUS. DIW is close the Metro Station "Stadtmitte" (e.g. take BUS 128 change at Kurt-Schumacher-Platz into U6; or take BUS X9 change at Ernst-Reuter-Platz into U2; or take the BUS TXL to Friedrichstraße/Unter den Linden and walk; other options are also possible). Arriving at Schönefeld Airport

Schönefeld Airport is in the southeast of the city center. The airport is accessible via bus and S-Bahn (train). Please buy an ABC ticket. DIW is close to the Metro Station "Stadtmitte" (e.g. take S-Bahn S45 change at Tempelhof into U6 but other options are also possible). DIW Berlin is close to the Metro Station "Stadtmitte" (e.g. take S-Bahn with the direction Ostbahnhof/Friedrichstraße change at Friedrichstraße into U6; or take the BUS TXL to Friedrichstraße/Unter den Linden and walk).
