Richard V. Burkhauser (Ph.D. Economics, University of Chicago, 1976) is chair of the Department of Policy Analysis and Management and the Sarah Gibson Blanding Professor of Policy Analysis in the College of Human Ecology at Cornell University. He is a DIW Research Associate. He is a member of the Panel Study on Income Dynamics Board of Overseers and on the editorial boards of *The Gerontologist*, *The Journal of Disability Policy Studies*, *The Review of Income and Wealth*, *Labor Economics*, *Research on Aging*, and *The Journal of Applied Social Science Studies*. Burkhauser was a member of the Technical Panel of the 1994-1996 Advisory Council on Social Security and the 1994-1996 National Academy of Social Insurance Panel on Disability Policy Reform.

Burkhauser has published widely in the area of United States and European social security retirement and disability policy. His current research interests focus on: The importance of the social environment on the work outcomes of people with disabilities; how disability influences economic well-being; how social security reforms will effect the work and economic well-being of older persons; and on cross-national comparisons of the economic well-being and work of older person.

Burkhauser's most recent co-authored work with John Bound reviews the economic literature on disability in the *Handbook of Labor Economics* (1999).
