3rd edition of the Berlin Internal Macroeconomics Workshop

The Berlin Macroeconomics Network is pleased to announce the third edition of the Berlin Internal Macroeconomics Workshop, to be held from 9:30am to 5:30pm on **Friday 8 December 2017**. The Berlin Internal Macroeconomics workshop series is organized by the Berlin community on an occasional basis to foster research in the field of Macroeconomics among its members. The third edition of this workshop is kindly supported by BERA (Berlin Economics Research Associates), DIW Berlin (German Institute for Economic Research) and the Society for Economics and Management at Humboldt University.

Every Berlin Internal Macroeconomics workshop features a special guest, who is a distinguished and well-known scholar in the field. The first edition was kindly attended by Professor Fabio Canova, the second edition by Professor Wouter Den Haan. We are honoured to announce that for the third edition Professor Jordi Galí from the Universitat Pompeu Fabra and CREI in Barcelona has confirmed his participation. Attendance of the workshop is open to all researchers in Macroeconomics (Ph.D. students, Post-Doctoral researchers, faculty members) from the Berlin area (including Potsdam and Frankfurt Oder) subject to a preliminary registration. Registration is free. However, the submission of a paper is only open to all Ph.D. students from the Berlin area, which includes Potsdam and Frankfurt Oder, as well as to Post-Doctoral researchers who are part of BERA (Berlin Economics Research Associates). Coauthored papers can be submitted, provided that at least one of the authors satisfies the above criteria and that he/she will be willing to present the paper, if accepted. Young Berlin researchers who do not fit within any of the two criteria above can still submit a paper, but their works will be considered only if there are still presentation slots available. Researchers not based in the Berlin-area who happen to be in Berlin on that day and would like to attend the workshop can also request to participate.

Following the workshop, those who are interested will go with the distinguished guest for drinks at the Christmas market in Gendarmenmarkt.

Enquiries, paper submissions and requests to participate as non-presenters should be directed to the following email address: berlinmacronetwork@gmail.com.

Submissions open on 1 October 2017 and will be considered until **22 October 2017**. Only full papers will be considered. Notifications of acceptance/rejection of papers should be expected by 12 November 2017. Registration for the workshop of both presenters and non-presenters should be done by 26 November 2017. Registration will only require confirmation of the intention to attend/present.
